Thomas Hatzichristos took an MSc degree in Surveying Engineering, from the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), in 1990. He awarded doctorate in 1998, from the same university on GIS and Computational Intelligence. He was a Lecturer (on fixed-term contract), at the Department of Geography, University of Aegean, from 1998 to 2000. From 2000 to 2022 he belonged to the Laboratory Teaching Staff of the NTUA. From 2023 he serves as assistant professor at the same university. Throughout period of employment taught courses on “GIS applications in urban and regional planning”, “Spatial analysis” etc. He is also a consultant in several public authorities and private firms on Geoinformatics and Spatial Analysis. He has participated in more than 70 GIS projects and more than 25 research projects. He has more than 60 publications. He was the President of the Greek GIS community (HellasGIS) for four years. He was the national representative of Greece in the Board of the European Directive INSPIRE.
